3	when polling the jury.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article 37.05, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Art. 37.05. POLLING THE JURY. (a) The State and $[\frac{1}{97}]$ the
8	defendant <u>each</u> [shall] have the right to have the jury polled, which
9	is done by calling separately the name <u>or identification number</u> of
10	each juror and asking him if the verdict is his. If all jurors, when
11	asked, answer in the affirmative, the verdict shall be entered upon
12	the minutes; but if any juror <u>answers</u> [answer] in the negative, the
13	jury shall retire again to consider its verdict.
14	(b) For the purposes of polling the jury in Subsection (a),
15	the judge may assign each juror an identification number to use in
16	place of the juror's name.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
