2 relating to an appropriation of money from the economic 3 stabilization fund to the fund for veterans' assistance for grants 4 to improve the level of health services provided to certain 5 veterans.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. (a) The amount of \$10 million is appropriated 8 from the economic stabilization fund to the fund for veterans' 9 assistance for use by the Texas Veterans Commission during the 10 state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2015, to make grants 11 in accordance with this Act and rules adopted by the commission to 12 improve the level of health services provided to veterans in this 13 state.

14 (b) From among organizations that apply in the time and manner established by the Texas Veterans Commission for a grant of 15 16 money under this Act, the commission shall select those organizations that best meet the criteria adopted for the purpose 17 by the commission. The criteria must require that the organization 18 applying for a grant of money under this Act use the money received 19 20 from the grant in a manner that improves the level of health 21 services provided by this state to veterans living more than 200 miles away from a veterans hospital. 22

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015, but only 24 if it receives a vote of two-thirds of the members present in each
