- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 31, Education Code, is 6
- 7 amended by adding Section 31.036 to read as follows:
- Sec. 31.036. ACCESS TO PRINTED INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS IN 8
- 9 ELECTRONIC FORMAT. (a) This section applies only to instructional
- materials or supplemental instructional materials provided in 10
- printed book format. 11
- 12 (b) The publisher of instructional materials
- supplemental instructional materials subject to this section 13
- purchased as provided by this chapter for a school district shall 14
- provide the district at no additional cost with access to the 15
- 16 materials in an electronic format as provided by this section.
- (c) Instructional materials or supplemental instructional 17
- materials may be accessed in an electronic format under this 18
- section only for educational purposes by: 19
- 20 (1) students enrolled in a course or subject for which
- the materials were purchased for the purpose of completing that 21
- course or subject and only for the period during which the student 22
- 23 is enrolled;
- 24 (2) teachers providing instruction in a course or

- 1 subject for which the materials were purchased for the purpose of
- 2 providing that instruction and only for the period during which the
- 3 materials in printed book format are assigned for that course or
- 4 subject; and
- 5 (3) school and district administrators for a district
- 6 campus at which a course or subject for which the materials were
- 7 purchased is provided and only for the period during which the
- 8 materials in printed book format are assigned for that course or
- 9 subject.
- 10 <u>(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules to administer this</u>
- 11 section.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to instructional materials or supplemental instructional materials
- 14 purchased under a contract entered into on or after the effective
- 15 date of this Act. Instructional materials or supplemental
- 16 instructional materials purchased under a contract entered into
- 17 before the effective date of this Act are governed by the law in
- 18 effect on the date the contract was entered into, and the former law
- 19 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
