1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to eligibility for appointment as a tabulation supervisor  
1-20 in an election.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 127.003(b), Election Code, is amended to  
1-23 read as follows:

1-24 (b) To be eligible for appointment, a person must be:

1-25 (1) trained in the operation of the automatic  
1-26 tabulating equipment installed at the counting station; and

1-27 (2) a registered voter of the political subdivision  
1-28 served by the authority establishing the counting station or an  
1-29 employee of the political subdivision that adopts or owns the  
1-30 voting system.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
