1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the designation of a site of unique value for the
 1-19 construction of a reservoir.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. The legislature, as authorized by Section
 1-22 16.051(g), Water Code, designates the site of the proposed Ringgold
 1-23 reservoir, to be located on the Little Wichita River in Clay County
 1-24 approximately one-half mile upstream from its confluence with the
 1-25 Red River, as having unique value for the construction of a dam and
 1-26 reservoir and further determines that the reservoir is necessary to
 1-27 meet water supply needs.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
