5	SECTION 1. Section 455.203, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (e) and (f) to read as follows:
7	(e) The course of instruction in massage therapy provided by
8	a massage school licensed under this chapter shall be classified as
9	a postsecondary education program.
10	(f) Massage schools that provide instruction to persons
11	beyond the age of compulsory education and are licensed under this
12	chapter to offer a course of instruction in massage therapy are
13	authorized to operate educational programs in massage therapy at
14	the postsecondary education level.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
