- 5 SECTION 1. Section 662.106(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) <u>September</u> [October] is Hydrocephalus Awareness Month
- 8 to:
- 9 (1) increase public awareness of hydrocephalus, a
- 10 serious neurological condition characterized by the abnormal
- 11 buildup of cerebrospinal fluids in the ventricles of the brain; and
- 12 (2) encourage the development of partnerships between
- 13 the federal government, health care professionals, and patient
- 14 advocacy groups to advance the public's understanding of the
- 15 condition, improve the diagnosis and treatment of the condition,
- 16 and support research for a cure.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
