A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to notice and information provided by a solid waste

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 361.954(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The collection, recycling, and reuse provisions of this
- 9 subchapter apply to computer equipment used and returned to the
- 10 manufacturer by a consumer in this state and, except as provided by
- 11 <u>Section 361.967</u>, do not impose any obligation on an owner or
- 12 operator of a solid waste facility or a commercial transporter of
- 13 <u>solid waste</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 361.966, Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 361.966. FEDERAL PREEMPTION; EXPIRATION. (a) If
- 17 federal law establishes a national program for the collection and
- 18 recycling of computer equipment and the commission determines that
- 19 the federal law substantially meets the purposes of <u>Sections</u>
- 20 <u>361.952</u> through <u>361.965</u> [this subchapter], the commission may adopt
- 21 an agency statement that interprets the federal law as preemptive
- 22 of those sections [this subchapter].
- 23 (b) Sections 361.952 through 361.965 expire [This
- 24 subchapter expires on the date the commission issues a statement

- 2 SECTION 3. Subchapter Y, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
- 3 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.967 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 361.967. NOTICE AND INFORMATION PROVIDED TO CONSUMER
- 5 BY SOLID WASTE FACILITY AND COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTER. (a) In this
- 6 section, "electronic waste" means computer equipment that is
- 7 eligible for collection under a manufacturer's recovery plan
- 8 adopted under Section 361.955.
- 9 (b) An owner or operator of a solid waste facility shall
- 10 post in a conspicuous location at the solid waste facility a sign
- 11 that encourages consumers to recycle electronic waste. An owner or
- 12 operator is not liable for electronic waste collected or disposed
- 13 of at the solid waste facility and is not required to remove
- 14 electronic waste collected or disposed of. An owner or operator is
- 15 <u>not in violation of this subsection if the owner or operator has</u>
- 16 made a good faith effort to comply with this subsection.
- 17 (c) A commercial transporter of solid waste who transports
- 18 waste to a solid waste facility shall provide each person who has

- 11 (1) offered for sale or sold to a consumer in this
- 12 state; or
- 13 (2) used by a consumer in this state and returned for

- 18 BY SOLID WASTE FACILITY AND COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTER. (a) In this
- 19 section, "electronic waste" means covered television equipment
- 20 that is eligible for collection under:
- 21 (1) a manufacturer's recovery plan adopted under
- 22 Section 361.978; or
- 23 (2) a manufacturer recycling leadership program
- 24 established under Section 361.979.

- 4 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
