A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the exemption from auctioneer regulation of certain 3 motor vehicle auctions. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 1802.002(a), Occupations 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) This chapter does not apply to: a sale conducted by order of a United States court 8 (1) 9 under Title 11, United States Code; (2) a sale conducted by an employee of the United 10 11 States, this state, or a political subdivision of this state in the 12 course and scope of employment; 13 (3) a sale conducted by a charitable, religious, or 14 civic organization, including an organization having a tax exempt status under Section 501(c), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or 15 16 organized as a nonprofit entity, if the person organizing, arranging, or conducting the auction receives no compensation; 17 18 (4) a sale conducted by any person of the person's property if the person is not engaged in the business of selling 19 20 property at auction on a recurring basis; 21 (5) a foreclosure sale of real property personally 22 conducted by a trustee under a deed of trust; 23 (6) a foreclosure sale of personal property personally 24 conducted by:

No. 1066 1 (A) a person who holds a security interest in the property, including a mortgage; or 2 3 (B) an employee or agent of a person described by Paragraph (A) acting in the course and scope of employment, if: 4 5 (i) the employee or agent is not otherwise 6 engaged in the auction business; and 7 (ii) all property for sale in the auction is 8 subject to a security agreement; 9 a sale conducted by sealed bid without the option (7) 10 of increasing or decreasing the amount of a bid; an auction conducted only for student training 11 (8) purposes as part of a course of study approved by the department; 12 (9) an auction conducted by a posted stockyard or 13 14 market agency as defined by the federal Packers and Stockyards Act 15 (7 U.S.C. Section 181 et seq.), as amended; 16 (10) an auction of livestock conducted by a nonprofit 17 livestock trade association chartered in this state, if the auction involves only the sale of livestock owned by members of the trade 18 association; 19 20 an auction conducted by a charitable or nonprofit (11)organization chartered in this state, if the auction: 21 22 is part of a fair that is organized under (A) 23 state, county, or municipal authority; and 24 (B) involves only the sale of property owned by 25 the organization's members; [or] (12) a sale or auction conducted outside of this 26 27 state; or

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(13) the sale of motor vehicles at auction by a person
who holds a wholesale motor vehicle auction general distinguishing
number issued by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
