A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the form of a motion to adopt an ordinance, resolution,
- 3 or order setting an ad valorem tax rate that exceeds the effective
- 4 tax rate.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 26.05(b), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) A taxing unit may not impose property taxes in any year
- 9 until the governing body has adopted a tax rate for that year, and
- 10 the annual tax rate must be set by ordinance, resolution, or order,
- 11 depending on the method prescribed by law for adoption of a law by
- 12 the governing body. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or order
- 13 setting the tax rate must be separate from the vote adopting the
- 14 budget. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or order setting a
- 15 tax rate that exceeds the effective tax rate must be a record vote.
- 16 A motion to adopt an ordinance, resolution, or order setting a tax
- 17 rate that exceeds the effective tax rate must be made in the
- 18 following form: "I move that [the property tax rate be increased by
- 19 the adoption of] a tax rate of (specify tax rate) be adopted, which
- 20 exceeds the effective tax rate by [is effectively a] (insert
- 21 percentage by which the proposed tax rate exceeds the effective tax
- 22 rate) percent [increase in the tax rate]." If the ordinance,
- 23 resolution, or order sets a tax rate that, if applied to the total
- 24 taxable value, will impose an amount of taxes to fund maintenance

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- 1 and operation expenditures of the taxing unit that exceeds the
- 2 amount of taxes imposed for that purpose in the preceding year, the
- 3 taxing unit must:
- 4 (1) include in the ordinance, resolution, or order in
- 5 type larger than the type used in any other portion of the document:
- 6 (A) the following statement: "THIS TAX RATE WILL
- 7 RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S
- 8 TAX RATE."; and
- 9 (B) if the tax rate exceeds the effective
- 10 maintenance and operations rate, the following statement: "THE TAX
- 11 RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY (INSERT PERCENTAGE BY WHICH THE
- 12 TAX RATE EXCEEDS THE EFFECTIVE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS RATE)
- 13 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A
- 14 \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$(Insert amount)."; and
- 15 (2) include on the home page of any Internet website
- 16 operated by the unit:
- 17 (A) the following statement: "(Insert name of
- 18 unit) ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE
- 19 AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE"; and
- 20 (B) if the tax rate exceeds the effective
- 21 maintenance and operations rate, the following statement: "THE TAX
- 22 RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY (INSERT PERCENTAGE BY WHICH THE
- 23 TAX RATE EXCEEDS THE EFFECTIVE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS RATE)
- 24 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A
- 25 \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$(Insert amount)."
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 27 the ad valorem tax rate of a taxing unit beginning with the 2015 tax

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- 1 year, except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section.
- 2 (b) If the governing body of a taxing unit adopted an ad
- 3 valorem tax rate for the taxing unit for the 2015 tax year before
- 4 the effective date of this Act, the change in law made by this Act
- 5 applies to the ad valorem tax rate of that taxing unit beginning
- 6 with the 2016 tax year, and the law in effect when the tax rate was
- 7 adopted applies to the 2015 tax year with respect to that taxing
- 8 unit.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
