 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to projects that a defense adjustment management authority
 1-20 may conduct.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 375.303, Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 375.303. DEFINITION [DEFINITIONS]. In this
 1-25 subchapter, "authority" [+

1-26 [(1) "Authority"] means a defense adjustment
 1-27 management authority created under this subchapter.

1-28 [(2) "Eligible project" means a program authorized by
 1-29 Section 379A.051 and a project as defined by Section 501.002 and
 1-30 Sections 505.151-505.156. Notwithstanding this definition,
 1-31 seeking a charter for or operating an open-enrollment charter
 1-32 school authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Education Code,
 1-33 shall not be an eligible project.]

1-34 SECTION 2. Subchapter O, Chapter 375, Local Government
 1-35 Code, is amended by adding Section 375.3035 to read as follows:

1-36 Sec. 375.3035. ELIGIBLE PROJECTS. (a) In this subchapter,
 1-37 eligible projects include only a:

1-38 (1) program authorized by Section 379A.051;

1-39 (2) project as defined by Section 501.002 and
 1-40 Sections 505.151-505.156;

1-41 (3) job training program for jobs in the health care,
 1-42 technology, or oil and gas industries; or

1-43 (4) project that relates to a public purpose of the
 1-44 district for which the authority receives a grant through a
 1-45 competitive grant program administered by the federal government or
 1-46 this state, including a program administered by the Parks and
 1-47 Wildlife Department, the Texas Department of Transportation, or the
 1-48 Texas Workforce Commission.

1-49 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), in this subchapter,
 1-50 seeking a charter for or operating an open-enrollment charter
 1-51 school authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Education Code, is
 1-52 not an eligible project.

1-53 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
