1-19 relating to the authority with whom certain political committees
 1-20 must file reports of political contributions and expenditures.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 254.130, Election Code, is amended to
 1-23 read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 254.130. AUTHORITY WITH WHOM REPORTS FILED. (a)
 1-25 Except as provided by Subsection (b), reports [Reports] filed under
 1-26 this subchapter shall be filed with the authority with whom the
 1-27 political committee's campaign treasurer appointment is required
 1-28 to be filed.

1-29 (b) A specific-purpose committee created to support or
 1-30 oppose a measure on the issuance of bonds by a school district shall
 1-31 file reports under this subchapter with the commission.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a report of political
 1-33 contributions or expenditures due on or after the effective date of
 1-34 this Act. A report of political contributions or expenditures due
 1-35 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
 1-36 effect on the date the report is due, and the former law is
 1-37 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
