H.B. No. 1119

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a study assessing the statewide need for the
3 replacement of mile markers on certain highways.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. (a) The Texas Department of Transportation, in
6 consultation with the Texas A&M Transportation Institute, shall
7 conduct a study assessing the statewide need for the replacement of
8 fallen or damaged mile markers on interstate highways where mile
9 markers are required to be installed under state or federal
10 guidelines.

11 (b) Not later than January 1, 2017, the department shall
12 submit a report on the results of the study and any recommendations
13 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
14 of representatives, and the presiding officer of each standing
15 committee of the legislature with jurisdiction over transportation
16 matters.

17 (c) This Act expires August 31, 2017.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
