A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "commission" means the
- 6 Railroad Commission of Texas.
- 7 SECTION 2. SCOPE OF STUDY. The commission shall conduct a
- 8 study on the availability of natural gas utility service in each
- 9 county in this state that borders the United Mexican States and has
- 10 a population of more than 800,000. In conducting the study, the
- 11 commission shall:
- 12 (1) identify in each county each census-designated
- 13 place that has a population of at least 500 and that lacks natural
- 14 gas utility service;
- 15 (2) consider the reasons for the lack of availability
- 16 of natural gas utility service in each census-designated place
- 17 identified in Subdivision (1) of this section;
- 18 (3) estimate the cost of expanding availability of
- 19 natural gas utility service in each census-designated place
- 20 identified in Subdivision (1) of this section; and
- 21 (4) study methods for making natural gas utility
- 22 service available throughout each county.
- SECTION 3. REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS. (a) The commission

- 1 governor, the speaker of the house, and the presiding officers of
- 2 the standing committees of the senate and house of representatives
- 3 with jurisdiction over the commission that includes the
- 4 commission's findings and recommendations relating to changes in
- 5 policies, rules, and statutes necessary to provide for or expedite
- 6 the extension of natural gas utility service to each county
- 7 described by Section 2 of this Act that lacks that service.
- 8 (b) The report must be issued by November 30, 2016.
- 9 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires December 1, 2016.
- 10 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 11 1, 2015.
