4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 201.6141 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 201.6141. TRANSPORTATION SAFETY AND ACCESS ADVISORY
8	COMMITTEE. (a) In this section, "committee" means the
9	Transportation Safety and Access Advisory Committee created under
10	this section.
11	(b) Section 2110.002, Government Code, does not apply to the
12	committee. The committee is composed of a representative appointed
13	by:
14	(1) AARP;
15	(2) the Texas chapter of the American Planning
16	Association;
17	(3) the Texas chapter of the American Society of
18	Landscape Architects;
19	(4) the Association of Texas Metropolitan Planning
20	Organizations;
21	(5) the department;
22	(6) the Department of Aging and Disability Services;
23	(7) the Department of State Health Services;
24	(8) an organization, selected by the department, that

- 1 represents bicyclists;
- 2 (9) an organization, selected by the department, that
- 3 represents persons with disabilities;
- 4 (10) the Texas Association of Counties; and
- 5 (11) the Texas Municipal League.
- 6 (c) Not later than December 1, 2015, the department shall
- 7 ensure that the representatives of the committee are appointed and
- 8 call the first meeting of the committee.
- 9 (d) The committee shall study methods, including
- 10 infrastructure additions such as sidewalks and bicycle lanes, the
- 11 department can use to improve the safety and access of all users of
- 12 state or federally funded transportation projects.
- (e) Not later than September 1, 2016, the committee shall
- 14 create and submit to the department a report on the methods
- 15 <u>described in Subsection (d).</u>
- 16 (f) The committee is abolished and this section expires
- 17 January 1, 2017.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
