4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 511, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 511.0103 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 511.0103. REPORT REGARDING RESTRAINT OF PREGNANT
8	PRISONER. (a) Not later than February 1 of each year, each county
9	jail shall submit to the commission a report regarding the jail's
10	use, during the preceding calendar year, of any type of restraints
11	to control or restrict the movement of a prisoner, including a limb
12	or other part of the prisoner, who:
13	(1) is pregnant; or
14	(2) gave birth three or fewer days before the use of
15	the restraints.
16	(b) The report must include the circumstances of each use of
17	restraints, including:
18	(1) the specific type of restraints used;
19	(2) what activity the prisoner was engaged in
20	immediately before being restrained;
21	(3) whether the prisoner was restrained during or
22	after delivery; and
23	(4) the reasons supporting the determination to use
24	the restraints, a description of the process by which the

1 determination was made, and the name and title of the person or 2 persons making the determination.

3 (c) The commission shall prescribe a form for the report 4 required for this section.

5 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2015, the Commission 6 on Jail Standards shall adopt rules to implement Section 511.0103, 7 Government Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
