- 2 relating to certain data reported to the Texas Higher Education

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 61.035, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) For purposes of this section, enrollment data
- 9 reported by institutions of higher education to the board must
- 10 <u>include:</u>

- 11 (1) the identification of any student who is a veteran
- 12 or military dependent; and
- (2) a designation of the type of any military higher
- 14 education benefit the student is eligible to receive, is currently
- 15 receiving, or has exhausted.
- 16 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to data
- 17 reported for students enrolled at an institution of higher
- 18 education beginning with the 2015-2016 academic year.
- 19 SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 20 shall adopt rules for the administration of Section 61.035,
- 21 Education Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as practicable after
- 22 this Act takes effect. For that purpose, the coordinating board may
- 23 adopt the initial rules in the manner provided by law for emergency
- 24 rules.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
