## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 38.03(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (b) It is  $\underline{a}$  [no] defense to prosecution under this section
- 9 that the arrest or search was unlawful.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 38.08, Penal Code, is amended to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 Sec. 38.08. EFFECT OF UNLAWFUL CUSTODY. It is  $\underline{a}$  [no]
- 13 defense to prosecution under Section 38.06 or 38.07 that the
- 14 custody was unlawful.
- 15 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 22 before that date.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
