Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding Section 202.008 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 202.008. FUEL UTILIZATION COVENANTS. (a) A property 8 owners' association or a declarant may not enforce or impose a 9 restrictive covenant that: 10 11 (1) requires a property owner to exclusively use a 12 particular fuel on the owner's property or exclusively use fuel provided by a particular supplier on the owner's property; or 13 14 (2) imposes a fee payable to any person for an owner to opt out of a requirement described by Subdivision (1). 15 16 (b) A restrictive covenant described by Subsection (a) is void and is unenforceable by any person. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 202.008, Property Code, as added by this Act, applies to a restrictive covenant imposed before, on, or after 19 the effective date of this Act. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
