## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing certain alternative fuel programs as
- 3 eligible for local government energy savings performance
- 4 contracts.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 302.001(4), Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (4) "Energy savings performance contract" means a
- 9 contract between a local government and a provider for energy or
- 10 water conservation or usage measures in which the estimated energy
- 11 savings, increase in billable revenues, or increase in meter
- 12 accuracy resulting from the measures is subject to guarantee to
- 13 offset the cost of the energy or water conservation or usage
- 14 measures over a specified period. The term includes a contract for
- 15 the installation or implementation of the following in new or
- 16 existing facilities, including all causally connected work:
- 17 (A) insulation of a building structure and
- 18 systems within the building;
- 19 (B) storm windows or doors, caulking or weather
- 20 stripping, multiglazed windows or doors, heat-absorbing or
- 21 heat-reflective glazed and coated window or door systems, or other
- 22 window or door system modifications that reduce energy consumption;
- (C) automatic energy control systems, including
- 24 computer software and technical data licenses;

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1 (D) heating, ventilating, or air-conditioning
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- 2 system modifications or replacements that reduce energy or water
- 3 consumption;
- 4 (E) lighting fixtures that increase energy
- 5 efficiency;
- 6 (F) energy recovery systems;
- 7 (G) electric systems improvements;
- 8 (H) water-conserving fixtures, appliances, and
- 9 equipment or the substitution of non-water-using fixtures,
- 10 appliances, and equipment;
- 11 (I) water-conserving landscape irrigation
- 12 equipment;
- 13 (J) landscaping measures that reduce watering
- 14 demands and capture and hold applied water and rainfall, including:
- 15 (i) landscape contouring, including the use
- 16 of berms, swales, and terraces; and
- 17 (ii) the use of soil amendments that
- 18 increase the water-holding capacity of the soil, including compost;
- 19 (K) rainwater harvesting equipment and equipment
- 20 to make use of water collected as part of a storm-water system
- 21 installed for water quality control;
- (L) equipment for recycling or reuse of water
- 23 originating on the premises or from other sources, including
- 24 treated municipal effluent;
- 25 (M) equipment needed to capture water from
- 26 nonconventional, alternate sources, including air-conditioning
- 27 condensate or graywater, for nonpotable uses;

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- 1 (N) metering or related equipment or systems that
- 2 improve the accuracy of billable-revenue-generation systems; [ex]
- 3 (O) <u>alternative fuel programs resulting in</u>
- 4 energy cost savings and reduced emissions for local government
- 5 vehicles, including fleet vehicles; or
- 6 <u>(P)</u> other energy or water conservation-related
- 7 improvements or equipment, including improvements or equipment
- 8 relating to renewable energy or nonconventional water sources or
- 9 water reuse.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
