1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the designation of a segment of U.S. Highway 287 in
 1-18 Midlothian as the Chris Kyle Memorial Highway.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-21 is amended by adding Section 225.102 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 225.102. CHRIS KYLE MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion
 1-23 of U.S. Highway 287 in Midlothian between its intersection with Rex
 1-24 Odom Drive and its intersection with Kimble Road is designated as
 1-25 the Chris Kyle Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to
 1-26 any other designation.

1-27 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-28 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-29 designation as the Chris Kyle Memorial Highway and any other
 1-30 appropriate information; and

1-31 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-32 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
