A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study by the Texas Water Development Board of the
- 3 hydrology and geology of the confined and unconfined aquifers in
- 4 this state.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) The Texas Water Development Board shall
- 7 conduct a study of the hydrology and geology of the confined and
- 8 unconfined aquifers in this state to determine:
- 9 (1) the quality and quantity of groundwater in those
- 10 aquifers, specifically regarding the salinity of those aquifers;
- 11 (2) whether those aguifers are tributary or
- 12 non-tributary;
- 13 (3) the contribution of those aquifers to any surface
- 14 flow of any water in this state;
- 15 (4) the contribution of those aquifers to any other
- 16 aquifer in this state; and
- 17 (5) the suitability of those aquifers for the disposal
- 18 of concentrate from desalination facilities through the use of
- 19 injection wells.
- 20 (b) In conducting the study, the board shall produce:
- 21 (1) a map that identifies the area and water quality of
- 22 the confined and unconfined aquifers in this state;
- 23 (2) a map that identifies which aquifers are tributary
- 24 and which are non-tributary;

- 1 (3) a report on the contribution of those aquifers to
- 2 any other aquifer in this state; and
- 3 (4) a report on the suitability of those aguifers for
- 4 the disposal of concentrate from desalination facilities through
- 5 the use of injection wells.
- 6 (c) Before conducting the study, the board shall determine:
- 7 (1) the minimum rate at which an aquifer must
- 8 contribute to another aquifer in this state or to the surface flow
- 9 of any water in this state in order to be included in the study; and
- 10 (2) the definition of "suitability" for the purposes
- 11 of Subsection (a)(5) of this section.
- 12 SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2016, the Texas Water
- 13 Development Board shall report the results of the study conducted
- 14 under this Act to the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
- 15 of representatives, and the standing committees of the senate and
- 16 the house of representatives that have jurisdiction over natural
- 17 resources.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
