8	(a) <u>Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), only</u> [Only] an
9	individual certified by the commission as a fire inspector may
10	conduct a fire safety inspection required by a state or local law,
11	rule, regulation, or ordinance. The following entities may provide
12	training related to fire safety inspections:
13	(1) the commission or a training facility certified by
14	the commission;
15	(2) the State Firefighters' and Fire Marshals'
16	Association of Texas or a training facility approved by that
17	association;
18	(3) the National Fire Protection Association;
19	(4) the International Code Council;
20	(5) any state agency with authority over fire safety
21	inspections; or
22	(6) any local agency authorized to provide the
23	training by a state agency described by Subdivision (5).
24	(a-1) For purposes of conducting a fire safety inspection

1	under Subsection (a), an individual is not required to be certified
2	by the commission if the inspection is conducted in a county with a
3	population of less than 250,000 and the individual:
4	(1) has completed training on fire safety inspections
5	offered by an entity described by that subsection; or
6	(2) is a member of a volunteer fire department.
7	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
