- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 264.124, Family Code, as added by
- 7 Chapter 423 (S.B. 430), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular
- 8 Session, 2013, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (e) On receipt of the verification required under
- 11 Subsection (b), or as provided by Subsection (d), the department
- 12 shall provide monetary assistance to a foster parent for day care
- 13 for a foster child, regardless of the type of day care chosen by the
- 14 foster parent. The department may not deny monetary assistance to
- 15 the foster parent based on the number of hours the foster child
- 16 attends day care each week.
- SECTION 2. Section 264.755, Family Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 19 <u>(f) On receipt of the verification required under</u>
- 20 Subsection (d), or as provided by Subsection (e), the department
- 21 shall provide monetary assistance to a relative or designated
- 22 caregiver for day care for the child, regardless of the type of day
- 23 care chosen by the relative or designated caregiver. The department
- 24 may not deny monetary assistance to the relative or designated

- 1 caregiver based on the number of hours the child attends day care
- 2 <u>each week.</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
