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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of the Department of Agriculture to 3 employ and commission peace officers as investigators. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by 5 adding Section 12.0131 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 12.0131. EMPLOYMENT OF PEACE OFFICERS. The department 7 may employ and commission peace officers as investigators to assist 8 9 the department in performing its duties. SECTION 2. Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, 10 is 11 amended to read as follows: 12 Art. 2.12. WHO ARE PEACE OFFICERS. The following are peace 13 officers: 14 (1) sheriffs, their deputies, and those reserve deputies who hold a permanent peace officer license issued under 15 Chapter 1701, Occupations Code; 16 (2) constables, deputy constables, and those reserve 17 deputy constables who hold a permanent peace officer license issued 18 under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code; 19 (3) marshals or police officers of an incorporated 20 21 city, town, or village, and those reserve municipal police officers who hold a permanent peace officer license issued under Chapter 22 23 1701, Occupations Code; (4) rangers and officers commissioned by the Public 24

Safety Commission and the Director of the Department of Public
 Safety;

4 district attorneys', and county attorneys' offices;

5 (6) law enforcement agents of the Texas Alcoholic6 Beverage Commission;

7 (7) each member of an arson investigating unit8 commissioned by a city, a county, or the state;

(12) airport security personnel commissioned as peace officers by the governing body of any political subdivision of this state, other than a city described by Subdivision (11), that operates an airport that serves commercial air carriers;

6 (35) [(36)] the fire marshal and any related officers,
7 inspectors, or investigators commissioned by a county under
8 Subchapter B, Chapter 352, Local Government Code; and

9 (36) investigators commissioned by the Department of
10 Agriculture under Section 12.0131, Agriculture Code.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
