15	(3) in the Korean Demilitarized Zone beginning on July

17	February 1, 1955].
18	(b) License plates issued under this section must include
19	the words "Korea Veteran[$_{ullet}$]" and bear a depiction of the

21	SECTION 2. Section 504.312, Transportation Code, is amended

23	Sec. 504.312. VIETNAM VETERANS. (a) The department shall
24	issue specialty license plates for persons who served in the United

1 States armed forces [during]: (1)during the period beginning on January 1, 1961, 2 and ending on August 14, 1974, and who received the National Defense 3 Service Medal; or 4 5 (2) in a combat zone in the Republic of Vietnam during the period beginning on July 1, 1958 [February 28, 1961], 6 and ending on March 28, 1973, and who received the Vietnam Service 7 Medal [May 7, 1975, in the case of a veteran who served in the 8 Republic of Vietnam during that period; or 9 10 [(2) the period beginning on August 5, 1964, and ending on May 7, 1975, in all other cases]. 11 12 (b) License plates issued under this section must include the words "Vietnam Veteran[-,]" and bear a depiction of the 13 14 appropriate medal. 15 SECTION 3. Section 504.313, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 16 Sec. 504.313. DESERT SHIELD OR DESERT STORM VETERANS. (a) 17 The department shall issue specialty license plates for persons who 18 19 served in the United States armed forces: (1) during the period beginning on [after] August 2, 20 21 [1,] 1990, and ending on November 30, 1995, and who received the National Defense Service Medal; or 22 (2) in a combat zone in support of Operation Desert 23 24 Shield or Desert Storm during the period beginning on August 2, 1990, and ending on November 30, 1995, and who received the 25 Southwest Asia Service Medal [before April 12, 1991]. 26 27 (b) License plates issued under this section must include

1 the words "Desert <u>Shield/Storm/Provide Comfort[-]</u>" and bear a
2 depiction of the appropriate medal.

3 SECTION 4. Section 504.202(e-1), Transportation Code, is 4 amended to read as follows:

5 (e-1) Other than license plates issued under Subsection 6 (h), license plates issued under this section may include, on 7 request:

(1) the emblem of the veteran's branch of service; or

9 (2) one emblem from another license plate to which the 10 person is entitled under Section 504.308, <u>504.311, 504.312,</u> 11 <u>504.313, 504.3135, 504.314,</u> 504.315, 504.316, <u>504.318,</u> or 504.319.

12 SECTION 5. The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles is not 13 required to issue specialty license plates under Sections 504.311, 14 504.312, and 504.313, Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, 15 until January 1, 2016.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
