- SECTION 2. Sections 615.023(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 18 are amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The state shall pay to the duly appointed or qualified
- 20 guardian or other legal representative of an eligible surviving
- 21 minor child:
- (1) $$400 \left[\frac{$200}{}\right]$ each month, if there is one surviving
- 23 child;
- (2) $$600 \left[\frac{$300}{} \right]$ each month, if there are two surviving

- 2 (3) \$800 [\$400] each month, if there are three or more
- 3 surviving children.
- 4 (b) A child's entitlement to assistance payable under this
- 5 section ends on the <u>last day of the month that includes the</u> child's
- 6 18th birthday. At that time, payments to any other surviving minor
- 7 children shall be adjusted, as necessary, to conform to the amounts
- 8 payable under Subsection (a).
- 9 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply in
- 10 relation to a payment of assistance made to survivors of certain
- 11 public servants on or after the effective date of this Act
- 12 regardless of the date the death of the public servant occurs.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
