- 6 SECTION 1. Section 615.022, Government Code, is amended to

- 8 Sec. 615.022. PAYMENT TO SURVIVORS. (a) If there is an
- 9 eligible surviving spouse, the state shall pay \$500,000 [\$250,000]
- 10 to the eligible surviving spouse.
- 11 (b) If there is no eligible surviving spouse, the state
- 12 shall pay \$500,000 [\$250,000] in equal shares to surviving
- 13 children.
- 14 (c) If there is no eligible surviving spouse or child, the
- 15 state shall pay \$500,000 [ $\frac{$250,000}{}$ ] in equal shares to surviving
- 16 parents.
- SECTION 2. Section 615.023(a), Government Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The state shall pay to the duly appointed or qualified
- 20 guardian or other legal representative of an eligible surviving
- 21 minor child:
- (1)  $$400 \left[\frac{$200}{}\right]$  each month, if there is one surviving

- (2)  $$600 \left[ \frac{$300}{} \right]$  each month, if there are two surviving

- 1 children; or
- 2 (3)  $\frac{$800}{}$  [\$\frac{\$400}{}] each month, if there are three or more
- 3 surviving children.
- 4 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act relating to
- 5 the death of certain public servants apply only in relation to a
- 6 death that occurs on or after September 1, 2015. Matters regarding
- 7 eligibility, payment, and other benefits in relation to a death
- 8 that occurs before September 1, 2015, are governed by the law in
- 9 effect when the death occurs, and the former law is continued in
- 10 effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
