- 3 SECTION 2. Section 361.067, Health and Safety Code, as
- 4 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for the
- 5 issuance, amendment, or renewal of a permit pending before the
- 6 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective
- 7 date of this Act. A permit issued, amended, or renewed before the
- 8 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 9 permit was issued, amended, or renewed, and the former law is
- 10 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
