- SECTION 2. Each general academic teaching institution other
- 17 than a public state college shall comply with Section 51.9746,
- 18 Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable
- 19 following the effective date of this Act, but not later than
- 20 February 1, 2016.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
