## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the acquisition and sale of unimproved real property by

- 3 an urban land bank.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 379C.004(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing body of a municipality may adopt an urban
- 8 land bank demonstration program in which the officer charged with
- 9 selling real property ordered sold pursuant to foreclosure of a tax
- 10 lien may sell certain eligible real property by private sale for
- 11 [purposes of] affordable housing development or other purposes as
- 12 provided by this chapter.
- SECTION 2. Sections 379C.014(a) and (c), Local Government
- 14 Code, as added by Chapter 1037 (H.B. 2840), Acts of the 83rd
- 15 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this chapter,
- 17 the land bank may <u>acquire and</u> sell <u>to a developer property intended</u>
- 18 for commercial use [to a developer to allow the construction of a
- 19 grocery store that has at least 6,000 square feet of enclosed space
- 20 and that offers for sale fresh produce and other food items for home
- 21 consumption].
- (c) A sale under this section within the four-year period
- 23 following the date of acquisition of the property by the land bank
- 24 is for a public purpose and satisfies the requirement under Section

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- 1 379C.009(b) that the property be sold within the four-year [that]
- 2 period to a qualified participating developer.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
