BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 21.0441(b), Education Code, is amended 1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 (b) The board's rules must permit an educator preparation program to admit in extraordinary circumstances a person who fails 1-24 to satisfy a grade point average requirement prescribed by 1-25 Subsection (a)(1)(A) or (B), provided that:

(1) not more than 10 percent of the total number of persons admitted to the program in a year fail to satisfy the requirement under Subsection (a)(1)(A) or (B);

1-33 1-34 1-35 certifies, based on documentation provided by the person, that the 1-36 person's work, business, or career experience demonstrates 1-37 achievement comparable to the academic achievement represented by the grade point average requirement. 1-38
