- Sec. 1081.056. QUORUM. Any  $\underline{\text{four}}$  [five] directors
- 21 constitute a quorum.
- Sec. 1081.057. VOTING REQUIREMENT. A concurrence of four
- 23 [five] directors is sufficient in any matter relating to district
- 24 business.
