3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 86.006, Election Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
6	follows:
7	(a) A marked ballot voted under this chapter must be
8	returned to the early voting clerk in the official carrier
9	envelope. The carrier envelope may be delivered in another
10	envelope and must be transported and delivered only by <u>:</u>
11	<u>(1)</u> mail <u>;</u>
12	(2) [or by] common or contract carrier; or
13	(3) subject to Subsection (a-1), in-person delivery by
14	the voter who voted the ballot.
15	(a-1) The voter may deliver a marked ballot in person to the
16	early voting clerk's office only while the polls are open on
17	election day. A voter who delivers a marked ballot in person must
18	present an acceptable form of identification described by Section
19	<u>63.0101.</u>
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

22 provided by Section 55, Article 111, Texas constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
