A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the designation of van-only parking spaces for use by persons with disabilities; creating an offense. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 469.052, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 6 7 (d) The commission by rule shall require, for a building or facility that is required under 28 C.F.R. Part 36 to designate one 8 9 or more van-accessible parking spaces, that at least one of those parking spaces be designated for use only by vans. 10 11 SECTION 2. Section 681.006(a), Transportation Code, is 12 amended to read as follows: (a) Subject to Section 681.009(e), a vehicle may be parked 13 14 for an unlimited period: (1) in a parking space or area that is designated 15 16 specifically for persons with physical disabilities, other than a space designated as van-only under Section 469.052(d), Government 17 Code, if: 18 (A) [(1)] the vehicle is being operated by or for 19 the transportation of a person with a disability; and 20 21 (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ there are: (i) [(A)] displayed on the vehicle special 22 23 license plates issued under Section 504.201; or 24 (ii) [(B)] placed on the rearview mirror of

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the vehicle's front windshield a disabled parking placard; or 1 2 (2) in a parking space designated as van-only under Section 469.052(d), Government Code, if: 3 4 (A) the requirements of Subdivision (1) are met; 5 and 6 (B) the vehicle is a van. SECTION 3. Section 681.009(b), Transportation Code, 7 is 8 amended to read as follows: (b) A political subdivision must designate a parking space 9 or area by conforming to the standards and specifications adopted 10 by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation under Section 11 469.052, Government Code [5(i), Article 9102, Revised Statutes], 12 relating to the identification and dimensions of parking spaces for 13 14 persons with disabilities. A person who owns or controls private 15 property used for parking may designate a parking space or area without conforming to those standards and specifications, unless 16 17 required to conform by law.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
