1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to a report on laws, standards, and policies regarding  
 1-21 parking for persons with disabilities to be prepared by the  
 1-22 Governor's Committee on People with Disabilities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 115, Human Resources Code, is amended by  
 1-25 adding Section 115.012 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 115.012. REPORT ON HANDICAPPED PARKING LAWS,  
 1-27 STANDARDS, AND POLICIES. (a) The committee, in coordination with  
 1-28 disability advocacy groups and disability-related organizations  
 1-29 located in both rural and urban areas of this state, shall review:

1-30 (1) laws of this state that apply to parking for  
 1-31 persons with disabilities;

1-32 (2) laws of other states that apply to parking for  
 1-33 persons with disabilities;

1-34 (3) requirements for parking for persons with  
 1-35 disabilities in:

1-36 (A) the federal Americans with Disabilities Act  
 1-37 of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) and related federal regulations;

1-38 (B) the 2010 Americans with Disabilities Act  
 1-39 Standards for Accessible Design; and

1-40 (C) the 2012 Texas Accessibility Standards; and

1-41 (4) policies on parking for persons with disabilities  
 1-42 in state-owned parking lots, including on the grounds of the State  
 1-43 Capitol.

1-44 (b) The committee shall create a report on the information  
 1-45 described by Subsection (a). Not later than November 1, 2016, the  
 1-46 committee shall submit the report to the governor, lieutenant  
 1-47 governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and standing  
 1-48 committees of the senate and house of representatives that have  
 1-49 jurisdiction over issues related to transportation.

1-50 (c) This section expires January 1, 2017.

1-51 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
