BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 623.219(a) and (b), Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a county that borders the United Mexican States, the commission 8 9 shall, with the consent of the port authority, designate the most direct route from: 10 11 (1) the Gateway International Bridge or the Veterans 12 International Bridge at Los Tomates to the entrance of the Port of Brownsville using State Highways 48 and 4 or United States Highways 13 14 77 and 83 or using United States Highway 77 and United States Highway 83, East Loop Corridor, and State Highway 4; and 15 16 (2) the Free Trade International Bridge to: (A) the entrance of the Port of Brownsville using 17 Farm-to-Market Road 509, United States Highways 77 and 83, 18 Farm-to-Market Road 511, State Highway 550, and East Loop (State 19 Highway 32); 20 21 (B) the eastern entrance of the Port of Harlingen 22 using Farm-to-Market Road 509, United States Highway 77 Business, 23 and Farm-to-Market Road 1846; (C) the western entrance of the Port of Harlingen 24

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1 using Farm-to-Market Roads 509 and 106;

2 (D) the southern entrance of the Harlingen 3 Industrial Park using Farm-to-Market Road 509; and

4 (E) the southern entrance of the Harlingen
5 Aerotropolis at Valley International Airport using Farm-to-Market
6 Road 509.

7 (b) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a 8 county that is adjacent to at least two counties with a population 9 of 550,000 or more, the commission shall, with the consent of the 10 port authority, designate the most direct route from:

(1) the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 523 and Moller Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using Farm-to-Market Roads 523 and 1495;

14 (2) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine 15 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highway 288; [and] 16 (3) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine 17 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highways 288 and 18 332 and Farm-to-Market Roads 523 and 1495;

19 (4) the intersection of North Velasco Boulevard and 20 South Avenue J in the city of Freeport to the entrance of Port 21 Freeport using North Velasco Boulevard and Farm-to-Market Road 22 <u>1495; and</u>

(5) 21441 Loop 419 in the city of Sweeny to the
 entrance of Port Freeport using Loop 419, State Highways 35 and 36,
 and Farm-to-Market Road 1495.
