H.B. No. 1321

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to route designation for the issuance of a permit for the
3 movement of oversize and overweight vehicles in certain counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 623.219(b), Transportation Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a
8 county that is adjacent to at least two counties with a population
9 of 550,000 or more, the commission shall, with the consent of the
10 port authority, designate the most direct route from:

11 (1) the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 523 and
12 Moller Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using Farm-to-Market
13 Roads 523 and 1495;

14 (2) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine
15 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highway 288; ~~and~~

16 (3) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine
17 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highways 288 and
18 332 and Farm-to-Market Roads 523 and 1495;

19 (4) the intersection of North Velasco Boulevard and
20 South Avenue J in the city of Freeport to the entrance of Port
21 Freeport using North Velasco Boulevard and Farm-to-Market Road
22 1495; and

23 (5) 21441 Loop 419 in the city of Sweeny to the
24 entrance of Port Freeport using Loop 419, State Highways 35 and 36,

1 and Farm-to-Market Road 1495.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
