2	relating to the sale or rental of certain motor vehicle tires
3	creating a criminal offense.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Title 6, Business & Commerce Code
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	TITLE 6. SALE, RENTAL, OR TRANSFER OF GOODS
8	SECTION 2. Title 6, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by
9	adding Chapter 205 to read as follows:

- 10 CHAPTER 205. SALE OR RENTAL OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE TIRES
- 11 Sec. 205.001. SALE OR RENTAL OF UNSAFE TIRES PROHIBITED.
- 12 (a) A person commits an offense if the person offers for sale or
- 13 rental, sells, or rents to another person a motor vehicle tire that
- 14 is or will be subject to inspection under Section 548.051,
- 15 Transportation Code, and that:
- 16 (1) has tire tread less than one-sixteenth of an inch
- 17 <u>deep;</u>
- 18 (2) has a localized worn spot that exposes the ply or
- 19 cord through the tread;
- 20 (3) has a tread or sidewall crack, cut, or snag as
- 21 measured on the outside of the tire that is more than one inch long
- 22 and deep enough to expose the body cords;
- 23 (4) has any visible bump, bulge, or knot apparently
- 24 related to tread or sidewall separation or partial failure of the

- 1 tire structure, including bead area;
- 2 (5) has been regrooved or recut below the original
- 3 groove depth, except for a special regroovable tire that has extra
- 4 undertread rubber for that purpose and is identified as a
- 5 regroovable tire;
- 6 (6) has been repaired temporarily by the use of a
- 7 blowout patch or boot;
- 8 (7) has worn tread wear indicators that contact the
- 9 road in any two adjacent major grooves in the center or middle of
- 10 the tire; or
- 11 (8) does not otherwise meet applicable Department of
- 12 Public Safety safety standards for the tire under Section 547.101,
- 13 Transportation Code.
- 14 (b) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
- 15 punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 or more than \$2,000.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
