BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 502.453, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 502.453. GOVERNMENT-OWNED VEHICLES; PUBLIC SCHOOL BUSES; FIRE-FIGHTING VEHICLES; COUNTY MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT 8 VEHICLES; U.S. COAST GUARD AUXILIARY VEHICLES. (a) The owner of a 9 motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer may annually apply for 10 registration under Section 502.451 and is exempt from the payment 11 12 of a registration fee under this chapter if the vehicle is: 13 (1) owned by and used exclusively in the service of: 14 (A) the United States; this state; or (B) 15 a county, municipality, or school district in 16 this state; 17 18 (2) owned by a commercial transportation company and used exclusively to provide public school transportation services 19 to a school district under Section 34.008, Education Code; 20 21 (3) designed and used exclusively for fire fighting; 22 owned by a volunteer fire department and used exclusively in the conduct of department business; 23 24 (5) privately owned and used by a volunteer

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- 1 exclusively in county marine law enforcement activities, including
- 2 rescue operations, under the direction of the sheriff's department;
- 3 [or]
- 4 (6) used by law enforcement under an alias for covert
- 5 criminal investigations; or
- 6 (7) owned by units of the United States Coast Guard
- 7 Auxiliary headquartered in Texas and used exclusively for conduct
- 8 of United States Coast Guard or Coast Guard Auxiliary business and
- 9 operations, including search and rescue, emergency communications,
- 10 and disaster operations.
- 11 (b) An application for registration under this section must
- 12 be made by a person having the authority to certify that the vehicle
- 13 meets the exemption requirements prescribed by Subsection (a). An
- 14 application for registration under this section of a fire-fighting
- 15 vehicle described by Subsection (a)(3) must include a reasonable
- 16 description of the vehicle and of any fire-fighting equipment
- 17 mounted on the vehicle. An application for registration under this
- 18 section of a vehicle described by Subsection (a)(5) must include a
- 19 statement signed by a person having the authority to act for a
- 20 sheriff's department that the vehicle is used exclusively in marine
- 21 law enforcement activities under the direction of the sheriff's
- 22 department. An application for registration under this section of
- 23 <u>a vehicle described by Subsection (a)(7) must include a statement</u>
- 24 signed by a person having authority to act for the United States
- 25 Coast Guard Auxiliary that the vehicle or trailer is used
- 26 exclusively in fulfillment of an authorized mission of the United
- 27 States Coast Guard or Coast Guard Auxiliary, including search and

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- 1 rescue, patrol, emergency communications, or disaster operations.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
