A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the exemption of certain vehicles from registration 3 fees. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 502.453, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 502.453. GOVERNMENT-OWNED VEHICLES; PUBLIC SCHOOL BUSES; FIRE-FIGHTING VEHICLES; COUNTY MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT 8 VEHICLES; U.S. COAST GUARD AUXILIARY VEHICLES. (a) The owner of a 9 motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer may annually apply for 10 registration under Section 502.451 and is exempt from the payment 11 12 of a registration fee under this chapter if the vehicle is: 13 (1) owned by and used exclusively in the service of: 14 (A) the United States; (B) this state; or 15 a county, municipality, or school district in 16 (C) this state; 17 18 (2) owned by a commercial transportation company and used exclusively to provide public school transportation services 19 to a school district under Section 34.008, Education Code; 20 21 (3) designed and used exclusively for fire fighting; 22 (4) owned by a volunteer fire department and used exclusively in the conduct of department business; 23 24 (5) privately owned and used by a volunteer

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1 exclusively in county marine law enforcement activities, including 2 rescue operations, under the direction of the sheriff's department; 3 [or]

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4 (6) used by law enforcement under an alias for covert
5 criminal investigations; or

6 <u>(7) owned by units of the United States Coast Guard</u> 7 <u>Auxiliary headquartered in Texas and used exclusively for conduct</u> 8 <u>of United States Coast Guard or Coast Guard Auxiliary business and</u> 9 <u>operations, including search and rescue, emergency communications,</u> 10 <u>and disaster operations</u>.

11 An application for registration under this section must (b) 12 be made by a person having the authority to certify that the vehicle meets the exemption requirements prescribed by Subsection (a). 13 An 14 application for registration under this section of a fire-fighting vehicle described by Subsection (a)(3) must include a reasonable 15 description of the vehicle and of any fire-fighting equipment 16 17 mounted on the vehicle. An application for registration under this section of a vehicle described by Subsection (a)(5) must include a 18 19 statement signed by a person having the authority to act for a sheriff's department that the vehicle is used exclusively in marine 20 law enforcement activities under the direction of the sheriff's 21 22 department. An application for registration under this section of a vehicle described by Subsection (a)(7) must include a statement 23 24 signed by a person having authority to act for the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary that the vehicle or trailer is used 25 26 exclusively in fulfillment of an authorized mission of the United States Coast Guard or Coast Guard Auxiliary, including search and 27

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1 rescue, patrol, emergency communications, or disaster operations.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
