The heading to Section 623.071, Transportation 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 623.071. PERMIT TO MOVE CERTAIN [HEAVY] EQUIPMENT. SECTION 2. Section 623.071, Transportation Code, is amended 8 by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows: 9 (c-1) The department may issue an annual permit that allows 10 a person to operate over a state highway or road a vehicle or 11 12 combination of vehicles that exceeds the length and height limits provided by law, except that: 13 14 (1) the maximum length allowed may not exceed 110 feet; and 15 (2) the maximum height allowed may not exceed 14 feet. 16 SECTION 3. Sections 623.076(a) and (a-1), Transportation 17 Code, are amended to read as follows: 18 An application for a permit under this subchapter must 19 (a) 20 be accompanied by a permit fee of: 21 (1)\$60 for a single-trip permit; 22 (2) \$120 for a permit that is valid for a period not 23 exceeding 30 days; (3) \$180 for a permit that is valid for a period of 31 24

1 days or more but not exceeding 60 days; 2 (4) \$240 for a permit that is valid for a period of 61 3 days or more but not exceeding 90 days; [or] 4 (5) \$270 for permit issued under Section а 5 623.071(c)(1) or (2); or 6 (6) \$960 for a permit issued under Section 7 623.071(c-1). 8 (a-1) The following amounts collected under Subsection (a) shall be deposited to the general revenue fund, 90 percent of the 9 remainder shall be deposited to the credit of the state highway 10 fund, and 10 percent of the remainder shall be deposited to the 11 credit of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles fund: 12 Amount of Fee Amount Allocated to General Revenue 13 14 Fund 15 \$60 (single-trip permit) \$30 16 \$120 (30-day permit) \$60 17 \$180 \$90 \$240 \$120 18 \$270 \$135 19 \$960 20 \$480 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
