- 26 an enrollment of 5,000 or more students.
- 27 (b) A student in first through grade six who attends an

- 1 elementary school may not be assigned for two consecutive school
- 2 years to a teacher who:
- 3 (1) has less than one year of teaching experience; or
- 4 (2) does not hold the appropriate certificate required
- 5 under Section 21.003.
- 6 (c) The requirement imposed by Subsection (b) does not apply
- 7 if the student's parent or other person standing in parental
- 8 relation to the student and a school counselor or school
- 9 administrator agree otherwise regarding assignment of the student
- 10 to a teacher.
- 11 (d) Subsection (b) does not apply to the first year a
- 12 student transfers into a school district.
- (e) Subsection (b) does not apply to teachers teaching
- 14 outside of the foundation curriculum stated in Section 28.002(1).
- 15 (f) The commissioner may grant a waiver from the
- 16 requirements of this section to a school district if the
- 17 commissioner finds that extreme circumstances in the district
- 18 warrant the waiver. The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary
- 19 to implement this section.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
