## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the application of certain concealed handgun license
- 3 laws to community supervision and corrections department officers
- 4 and juvenile probation officers; reducing a fee.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 411.1882(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A person who is serving in this state as a judge or
- 9 justice of a federal court, as an active judicial officer  $[\tau]$  as
- 10 defined by Section 411.201, [ex] as a district attorney, assistant
- 11 district attorney, criminal district attorney, assistant criminal
- 12 district attorney, county attorney, or assistant county attorney,
- 13 as a supervision officer as defined by Section 2, Article 42.12,
- 14 Code of Criminal Procedure, or as a juvenile probation officer may
- 15 establish handgun proficiency for the purposes of this subchapter
- 16 by obtaining from a handgun proficiency instructor approved by the
- 17 Texas Commission on Law Enforcement for purposes of Section
- 18 1702.1675, Occupations Code, a sworn statement that indicates that
- 19 the person, during the 12-month period preceding the date of the
- 20 person's application to the department, demonstrated to the
- 21 instructor proficiency in the use of handguns.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Section 411.1953 to read as follows:
- Sec. 411.1953. REDUCTION OF FEES FOR COMMUNITY SUPERVISION

- 1 AND CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENT OFFICERS AND JUVENILE PROBATION
- 2 OFFICERS. Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 3 an applicant who is serving in this state as a supervision officer,
- 4 as defined by Section 2, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 5 or as a juvenile probation officer shall pay a fee of \$25 for the
- 6 issuance of an original or renewed license under this subchapter.
- 7 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to a concealed handgun license issued or renewed on or after the
- 9 effective date of this Act. A concealed handgun license issued or
- 10 renewed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law
- 11 in effect on the date the license was issued or renewed, and the
- 12 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
