- 8 prosecution or defense.] State's counsel may open and conclude the
- 9 argument in the case.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a criminal proceeding that commences on or after the effective
- 12 date of this Act. A criminal proceeding that commences before the
- 13 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 14 date the proceeding commences, and the former law is continued in
- 15 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
