- 17 <u>(a-2)</u> To be eligible as a representative of the public
- 18 required under subsection (a) a person must be:
- 19 (1) a person who has not served in elected office; and
- 20 (2) <u>a person who has not been employed by a government</u>

- 22 (b) If a person serving as a trustee ceases to meet an
- 23 eligibility requirement under this section (a), the

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 1 845.003, Government Code, regarding the eligibility requirements 2 of members of the board of trustees of the Texas County and District 3 4 Retirement System, does not affect the entitlement of a member serving on the board immediately before the effective date of this 5 6 Act to continue to serve as a member of the board for the remainder of the member's term. As the terms of board members expire or as a 7 8 vacancy occurs on the board, the governor shall appoint a member to the board as necessary to comply with Section 845.003(a-1) and 9 (a-2), Government Code, as added by this Act. 10

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
