- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2256.008(a), Government Code, is amended

- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and (e), the
- 8 treasurer, the chief financial officer if the treasurer is not the
- 9 chief financial officer, and the investment officer of a local
- 10 government shall:
- 11 (1) attend at least one training session from an
- 12 independent source approved by the governing body of the local
- 13 government or a designated investment committee advising the
- 14 investment officer as provided for in the investment policy of the
- 15 local government and containing at least 10 hours of instruction
- 16 relating to the treasurer's or officer's responsibilities under
- 17 this subchapter within 12 months after taking office or assuming
- 18 duties; and
- 19 (2) except as provided by Subsections (b) and (e),
- 20 attend an investment training session not less than once in a
- 21 two-year period that begins on the first day of that local
- 22 government's fiscal year and consists of the two consecutive fiscal
- 23 years after that date, and receive not less than six [10] hours of

- 1 subchapter from an independent source approved by the governing
