BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 254.0401, Election Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsections (a-1) and (c) and adding Subsections (e-1) and 8 (g) to read as follows:

9 (a-1) The county clerk of a county with a population of 10 <u>50,000</u> [800,000] or more <u>that maintains an Internet website</u> shall 11 make a report filed with the clerk by a candidate, officeholder, or 12 specific-purpose committee under this subchapter in connection 13 with a county office or the office of county commissioner available 14 to the public on the county's Internet website not later than the 15 fifth business day after the date the report is received.

16 (c) The clerk of a municipality with a population of 50,000 [500,000] or more that maintains an Internet website shall make a 17 report filed with the clerk by a candidate, officeholder, or 18 specific-purpose committee under this subchapter in connection 19 20 with the office of mayor or member of the municipality's governing 21 body available to the public on the municipality's Internet website not later than the fifth business day after the date the report is 22 23 received.

required by Subsection (a-1) or (c), the authority with whom the 1 report is filed may remove each portion, other than city, state, and 2 zip code, of the address of a person listed as having made a 3 political contribution to the person filing the report. The address 4 5 information removed must remain available on the report maintained in the authority's office. 6 7 (g) A report made available on an Internet website under 8 this section must be accessible on that website until the fifth anniversary of the date the report is first made available. 9 10 SECTION 2. 3 (c) A report to which Subsection (b) <u>or (b-1)</u> applies must 4 be available to the public on the Internet website not later than 5 the fifth business day after the date the report is filed with the 6 school district.

Before making a report available on the Internet under 7 (e) this section, the school district or public junior college district 8 may remove each portion, other than city, state, and zip code, of 9 the address of a person listed as having made a political 10 contribution to the person filing the report. If the address 11 12 information is removed as permitted by this subsection, the information must remain available on the report maintained in the 13 14 [school] district's office.

15 (f) A report made available on an Internet website under 16 this section must be accessible on that website until the fifth 17 anniversary of the date the report is first made available.

18 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 19 254.0401 and 254.04011, Election Code, apply only to a report of 20 political contributions and expenditures that is required to be 21 filed under Chapter 254, Election Code, on or after the effective 22 date of this Act.
