6	SECTION 1. Section 101.064, Civil Practice and Remedies
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 101.064. LAND ACQUIRED UNDER FORECLOSURE OF LIEN OR BY
9	CONVEYANCE IN SATISFACTION OF CERTAIN TAX DEBT. (a) This section
10	applies only to a political subdivision of this state
11	[municipality] that acquires land:
12	(1) as a result of [ <del>at a sale following</del> ] the
13	foreclosure of a lien held by the political subdivision, including
14	land that was bid off to the political subdivision under Section
15	<u>34.01, Tax Code; or</u>
16	(2) under Section 31.061, Tax Code [municipality].
17	(b) This chapter does not apply to a claim that:
18	(1) arises after the date the land was acquired and
19	before the date the land is sold, conveyed, or exchanged by the
20	political subdivision [municipality]; and
21	(2) arises from:
22	(A) the condition of the land;
23	(B) a premises defect on the land; or
24	(C) an action committed by any person, other than

an agent or employee of the <u>political subdivision</u> [municipality],
on the land.

3 (c) In this section, [the term] "land" includes any building 4 or improvement located on land acquired by a <u>political subdivision</u> 5 [<u>municipality</u>].

6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a claim that arises on or after the effective date of this Act, 7 regardless of whether the land was acquired by a political 8 subdivision before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. A 9 claim that arises before the effective date of this Act is governed 10 by the law applicable to the claim immediately before the effective 11 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that 12 13 purpose.

14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
