## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 55.1781 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 55.1781. PRAIRIE VIEW A&M UNIVERSITY; ADDITIONAL
8	BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted under this
9	subchapter, the board of regents of The Texas A&M University System
10	may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or
11	equip property and facilities, including roads and related
12	infrastructure, for Prairie View A&M University for the following
13	projects to be financed by the issuance of bonds in accordance with
14	a systemwide revenue financing program and secured as provided by
15	that program, in aggregate principal amounts not to exceed:
16	(1) \$30,790,000 for a fabrication center and capital

- 18 (2) \$10 million for the Innovation Commercialization
- 19 Center for Entrepreneurs facility.
- 20 (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of the
- 21 bonds authorized by this section all or any part of the revenue
- funds of an institution, branch, or entity of The Texas A&M 22
- University System, including student tuition charges. The amount 23
- of a pledge made under this subsection may not be reduced or 24

- 1 abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds
- 2 issued to refund those bonds, are outstanding.
- 3 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board to
- 4 meet its obligations under this section, the board may transfer
- 5 funds among institutions, branches, and entities of The Texas A&M
- 6 University System to ensure the most equitable and efficient
- 7 <u>allocation of available resources for each institution, branch, or</u>
- 8 entity to carry out its duties and purposes.
- 9 (d) Any portion of the proceeds of bonds authorized by this
- 10 section that is not required for the specific project for which the
- 11 bonds are authorized may be used to renovate existing structures
- 12 and facilities at Prairie View A&M University.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
